






# Directions for Entering Course Requests in SIS StudentVUE

<p><b>Course Requests</b> In this section, you should already see Health &amp; PE 10 listed if you are a current 9th grader.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. On the left side bar, select </li> <li>2. To enter course requests: click </li> <li>3. Search for each course using the Click the magnifying glass and click "Reset". Now, type in the 6 digit course code from the course selection sheet and click </li> <li>4. If you would like to delete the request, click under the "Action" column.</li> </ol>
<p>Elective Alternate Requests <i>(All students must enter <b>at least 2 but no more than 4 alternate electives</b>)</i></p> <p><b>Alternate courses must be added in preferential order</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To enter elective alternate requests: click </li> <li>2. <b>In Preference Order</b></li> <li>3. Search for each course using the <input type="text" value="Course ID"/> Click the magnifying glass and click "Rest". Now, type in the 6 digit course code from the course selection sheet and click </li> <li>4. If you would like to delete the alternate request, click under the "Action" column.</li> </ol>
<p><b>Your completed requests should include 7 credits and at least 2 alternate electives</b></p>	<p><b>Things to Consider:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Standard or Advanced Diploma Requirements</li> <li>● 4 Core Classes (English, Social Studies, Math, &amp; Science)</li> <li>● Standard, Honors, AP or Dual Enrolled</li> <li>● Completion of 9th and 10th Grade Health &amp; PE Classes are mandatory</li> <li>● Completion of Economics/Personal Finance is mandatory</li> <li>● World Language</li> <li>● Electives (including sequential)</li> </ul>
